## Complaint CASE NO. 247 OF 2025

### **ORDER:**

This order may be read with the reference to the previous order dated **17.03.2025**.

2. The complainant is absent. However, an email dated 01.06.2026 has been received from the complainant mentioning therein that the sought information is still pending.

3. The respondent PIO, represented by Ms. Harjit Kaur, Clerk, states that the reply has already been sent to the complainant and also submits a detailed written submission vide letter dated 17.03.2026 as directed at the last hearing, which is taken on record. Furthermore, the respondent proffered an oral explanation of the facts. Consequently, I am satisfied that the PIO acted in good faith and there was no malafide intent on the part of the PIO to deny or delay the sought information.

4. After going through the reply filed by the respondent and hearing the respondent, it is ascertained that the respondent has provided appropriate and permissible reply to the complainant. Further, it has also been ascertained that this is a case of grievance of the complainant who has attempted to find redressal thereof by filing complaint case in the Commission. The perception of the complainant that filing of complaint case under RTI Act can be used as a mechanism for redressal of his grievance is beyond the paradigm of the Act. The Commission advises the complainant to approach the competent forum or Court for redressal of his grievance as it is unable to go outside the jurisdiction stipulated by the RTI Act.

5. In wake of aforementioned, this complaint case is hereby devoid of merit and hence **disposed of and closed**. Copy of the orders be sent to the parties.
