The appellant is also advised to go through the information which has already been provided and also which would be provided by the respondent and revert back to the respondent PIO in case of any deficiency found in the information well in time to enable the respondent to remove the same under intimation to the Commission. On receipt of the rebuttal, the respondent is also directed to remove the deficiencies, if any, pointed out by the appellant, by or on the next date of hearing.

5. With this, the case is **adjourned to 10th September, 2026 at 11:00 A. M.** for hearing at Chandigarh. Copies of the order be sent to the parties.

He is also advised to send the same to the respondent PIO in advance in advance so that the respondent could file a rejoinder, if any, to it.

6. The parties concerned are directed to remain present on the next date of hearing, failing which the case will be decided on merit, ex-parte.

7. With this, the case is **adjourned to 10th September, 2026 at 11:00 A. M.** for hearing at Chandigarh. Copies of the order be sent to the parties.
