They may take a note that in case they do not file their written reply and does not avail themselves of the opportunity of personal hearing on the next date, it will be presumed that they have nothing to say and the Commission will proceed ex-parte.

5. So far as the deficiencies are concerned, it is observed that deficiencies filed by the appellant is not available in the case file. Accordingly, the appellant is directed to submit the same in an annotated form with regard to the RTI application within thirty days from the issue of this order to the respondent PIO with a copy to the Commission, failing which, the decision will be taken on merit, ex-parte. It is further clarified that in case no deficiency will be sent by the appellant in an annotated form, no further adjournment will be given in this case.

6. It is further clarified to the respondent that in case of their absence on the next date of hearing, their presence will be procured by issuing **BAILABLE WARRANTS** and/or disciplinary action may be recommended in this case to the competent authority.
