"2. The appellant submits that a complaint was filed by Sh. Pritpal Singh against him and has sought the following information:

1. Current status of Complaint submitted at Police Station, Phase:1, S.A.S. Nagar bearing number **785/5D dated 09.06.2022.**

2. Current status of investigation in **FIR No.124, Dated: 21.06.2022, registered as P.S.-Phase-1, S.A.S. Nagar under Section/s 419, 465, 500 of IPC read with Section 66 E of Information and Technology Act 2000.** It is pertinent to mention here that above mentioned FIR was registered upon the **complaint no.3110-S-SSP, dated 29.05.2019** but till date no ^{Further} action has been taken against the accused even after the passing of more than 5 year and 6 months approximately.

3. *Further he has requested to direct the respondent PIO to supply the complete information. However, the respondent submits that the concerned case file is not traceable and requested for an adjournment in this case.*
4. *The appellant is seeking the information on three points from the respondent PIO. Thereafter, he filed the first appeal before the First Appellate Authority. Feeling aggrieved, he filed Second Appeal before the Commission to get the information.*
5. *The appellant submits that FIR No. 124 dated 21.06.2022 in which the report under Section 173 CrPC (old) has been filed and it is matter of evidence as a criminal case is pending i.e. Point No. 2 of the RTI application.*
6. *With regard to Point No. 1, the appellant has sought an action taken concerning a complaint lodged at Police Station Phase 1, bearing no. 785/ 5D dated 09.06.2022. The appellant further submits that the said complaint was lodged against the owner of a dog as the dog has bitten him and no prompt action has been taken by the owner of the dog to save his skin and due to his negligence he was remained under treatment. He further submits that the said dog was also not registered by the owner in the Municipal Corporation, Mohali and no action is being taken by the police authorities.*
7. *With regard to Point No. 3 of the RTI, the appellant has sought an action taken concerning a complaint lodged at Police Post Phase-6, bearing no. 90/ 5D dated 16.08.2023. the said complaint was lodged as few persons on a car threatened my son, after stopping the car of his son, and the videography done by his son from inside the car along with the complaint was lodged and also informed about the incidence on 112 but no action appears to be taken by the police authorities and has sought an action taken on the same.*

8. *After hearing the submissions made by the appellant, under Section 25 (5) of the RTI Act, 2005, this fact is brought to the knowledge of Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, to look into the matter as the first complaint was filed by the appellant on 09.06.2022 and the other complaint was filed by the appellant 16.08.2023 but no action has bene taken by the police till date. As the delay is fatal and it is the direct infringement in the fundamental right of the Citizens under Section 21 of the Constitution. So in the present scenario the appellant should not go pillar to post to get the justice as justice is a fundamental right of bonafide citizen of India.*
9. *So Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, is directed to appoint/depute a competent person to file written reply in this regard.*
10. *Also, a copy of this order is **being sent** to the Sh. Jashanpreet Singh (M:8645830000), SHO, Police Station, Phase-1, Mohali to remain present, in person, on the next date of hearing. Also, the Senior Superintendent of Police, Mohali, is directed to ensure the presence of the concerned officials i.e. Sh. Jashanpreet Singh, SHO and Sh. Sukhbir Singh ASI. It is also clarified that in case of defiance of this order, the presence of the concerned officials will be procured by issuing **BAILABLE WARRANTS** and/or disciplinary action may be recommended in this case to the **Director General of Police, Punjab.**"*

ORDER

The RTI application is dated 23.04.2024 vide which the appellant has sought information as enumerated in his RTI application. First appeal was filed with the First Appellate Authority (hereinafter FAA) on 06.06.2024 and second appeal was filed in the Commission on 19.11.2024 under Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005 (hereinafter RTI Act). Rajinder Kumar and Ms. Karamjeet Kaur made the written submissions that their personal information may not be supplied to the appellant.

3. In light of the above, the parties concerned are directed to make their final submissions, if any, within 30 days from the issue of this order, failing which, the decision will be taken as per the record available in the case file

4. As such, the order in this case is '**Reserved**', which will be pronounced later on.
