ORDER

Heard through facility of Software/application 'CISCO Webex Meetings'.

The RTI request is dated 31.05.2017. First appeal is dated 11.07.2019. Second appeal has been received in the Commission on 09.06.2020.

On the last date of hearing, held on 18.10.2021 ;

- i) Sh. Harpreet Singh, Labour Conciliation Officer, who appeared with Sh. Shailendra Singh Negi, RTI Clerk, stated that available information was supplied to the appellant and for the information, which is not available in the office-record, a reply was given to him vide letter no. 14579 dated 12.10.2021 through registered post.
- ii) The appellant stated that whatever information/replies, which were given to him is not signed by concerned officer/official of the respondent office.
- iii) On this, Sh. Harpreet Singh, Labour Conciliation Officer, stated that the information, which was given to the appellant is in the same manner as it exists in official-record.
- iv) The appellant was advised to visit the office of the respondent PIO on 21.10.2021 at 11:00 A. M. to identify the information.
- v) The respondent PIO concerned was directed to facilitate the appellant to inspect the relevant official record during his visit to the office and was directed to supply the required information to the appellant, which would be identified by him after inspection.
- vi) The respondent PIO concerned was directed to file a reply, in writing, in an affidavit (If the information is not available or found un-signed in the office-record) mentioning that the information/documents(already supplied) found unsigned from the official record and given to the appellant in the same manner as it exists in official-record and send the same to the appellant with a copy to the Commission.

- vii) An opportunity was given to the appellant to confirm whether he received the information/reply and also to point out deficiencies, if any, in the information supplied to him, in writing, to the respondent PIO well in time so that the same could be removed by the respondent concerned.

Sh. Shailendra Singh Negi, RTI Clerk, who appeared on behalf of the respondent PIO in today's hearing, states that in compliance to the order dated 18.10.2021, a reply dated 17.12.2021 in an affidavit has already been sent to the appellant vide letter no. 18150 dated 17.12.2021 through an e-mail. He also intimates the Commission that a reply has also been sent to the Commission vide letter no. 18151 dated 17.12.2021, which has been received in the Commission through an e-mail. It, alongwith a copy of reply given in an affidavit, is taken on record.

The appellant, Sh. Parmod Kumar, who appeared in person in today's hearing, states that he has received a copy of affidavit through e-mail not in original.

The respondent PIO is directed to send the affidavit dated 17.12.2021 to the Appellant through registered post at his residential address under intimation to the Commission.

As no cause of action is left in this case, hence, the show-cause issued to the concerned respondent PIO vide orders dated 08.03.2021 is dropped and the case is announced as disposed of and closed with the directions to the respondent PIO concerned to comply with the above-announced order.

appeal has been received in the Commission on 27.01.2021.

On the last date of hearing, held on 27.10.2021 ;

- i) The appellant, Sh. Ashok Kumar Watts, stated that no information was supplied to him by the respondent PIO.
- ii) Sh. Ashish Kumar, Superintendent of LG – III Branch, stated that a reply was given to the appellant, intimating that the information sought for by him(appellant) is regarding action-taken on complaints dated 17.10.2018 and 10.11.2020 and an enquiry is going on the said complaints and matter is under process with the Government of Punjab.
- iii) The PIO concerned, who is Sh. Ashish Kumar, Superintendent of LG - III Branch, was directed to submit a reply in an affidavit under his signatures to each and every query, raised by the appellant through his RTI request and send a copy of that reply in advance to the appellant through registered post with a copy to the Commission.
