### **ORDER**

## **ORDER**

2. The appellant submits that he has sought the information i.e. a statement given by Dr. Sarabdeep Singh, Anesthetist, submitted by him during inquiry conducted by the Medical Board constituted by Civil Surgeon, Amritsar, who enquire into the matter of death of Smt. Sunita Aneja due to negligence of Dr. Parveen Devgan and others in the year 2019.

3. He further submits that the respondent has not provided him the statement of Dr. Sarabdeep Singh and requested for the same.

4. Keeping in view the submissions made by the appellant, the directions are given to the respondent PIO, Dr. Jaspal Singh to file an affidavit, duly sworn that no statement of Dr. Sarabdeep Singh, Anesthetist, is available on record and in case the same is available then a copy of the same be supplied to the appellant under intimation to the Commission.

5. It is also a fact that the other case of the appellant i.e. AC 7518 of 2025 is listed for hearing today in which the appellant submitted a copy of an action taken by the Punjab Medical Council with regard to the renewal of registration of Dr. Parveen Devgan, a copy of which is attached herewith. It is also a fact that Punjab Medical council issued a letter bearing no. 5962 dated 08.08.2024 in which, it is stated that Dr. Parveen Devgan doing illegal practice and operate the patients in Altec Hospital, Amritsar which is against the Punjab Medical Registration Act and National Medical Commission Act.

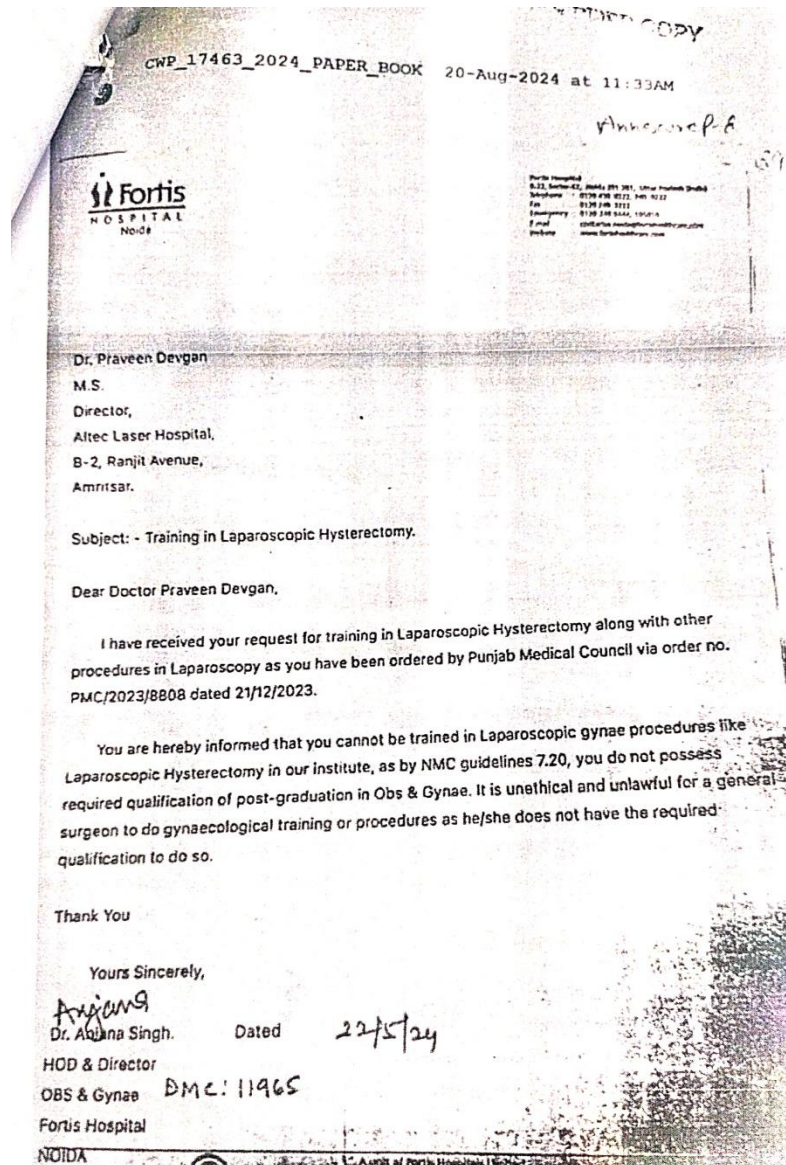

7. The mandate of the RTI Act, 2005, to promote the transparency and accountability in every public authority and to curb corruption.

8. Keeping in view of the above, the **Dr. RupinderBakshi, Registrar-cum-Public Information officer, Punjab Medical Council, Mohali** is impleaded as a necessary party in this case with the directions to submit the reply by way of an affidavit along with supporting documents as follows:

- i. Whether any court case is pending which was filed by Dr. Parveen Devgan, if so, then the decisions of the Hon'ble Court in each and every case be submitted.
- ii. The renewal of Registration of Dr. Parveen Devgan the decision has been taken by the General Body Meeting, a complete agenda along with the decision taken by the General body be submitted.
- iii. To submit the counter submissions with regard to the letter issued by the Fortis Hospital to Dr. Parveen Devgan, a copy of which is attached herewith.
- iv. From the above, it has transpired that Dr. Parveen Devgan cannot be trained in Laparoscopic Gynae Procedure like hysterectomy as he does not possessed the required qualification of post-graduation in Obs. and Gynae. Since, the registration number has been allotted to Dr. Parveen Devgan by the Punjab Medical Council, therefore, the qualification possessed by Dr. Parveen Devgan be submitted along with the specific reply whether the letter issued by Fortis Hospital, mentioned herein, is sustainable in the eyes of Law.
- v. Whether any statement has been received of Dr. Sarabdeep Singh, PMC Registration Number 52470, Alteclazor and Super Specialty Centre while taking the decision by General Body who has taken the decision in its meeting on 25.09.2024 for the renewal of the License of Dr. Parveen Devgan.
- vi. Whether Anesthetist is required for Laparoscopic Gynae Procedure like hysterectomy, if not then the specific reply be filed
