ORDER

This order may be read with reference to the previous order dated 23.04.2025 vide which the order was reserved to be pronounced.

2. The appellant sought the following information:

This information is related to the godowns in the name and style of M/s Bahadur Singh Co-owner, Phaguwal Vill., Tehsil Bhawanigarh Distt. Sangrur for the period 01-01-2002 to 15-10-2022. That the applicant requires the below mentioned information under RTI Act,2005:-

1. Attested Copy of the very first Agreement and copy all the renewal Agreement executed between PSWC and Co-owners/owners of godown alongwith all the documents annexed with Agreement for the above mentioned period.
2. Attested copy of tax deducted from the share of Ashok Kumar HUF, Sh. Sham Lal s/o Late Sh. Puran Chand for the above mentioned period. In other words attested copy of TDS deducted from the share of Ashok Kumar HUF & Sh. Sham Lal and deposited it with Income Tax Department for the above mentioned period.
3. Complete month wise Detail of Rent of Ashok Kumar HUF and Sh. Sham Lal which is withheld by PSWC.
4. Complete month wise detail of rent given to Ashok Kumar HUF.
5. Attested copy of order of any authority (court and management of PSWC) by which the rent is withheld by PSWC. And attested copy of all proceedings related to withheld of rent of Ashok Kumar HUF.

6. Attested copy of any letter written by DM, PSWC Sangrur to withheld the share of Ashok Kumar HUF, as well as of Sh. Sham Lal and copy of all proceedings related to it.
7. Attested copy of all the agreements executed between new owners of godown and PSWC for the above mentioned period.
8. Attested copy of affidavits given by new owner at the time of execution of Agreement.
9. Attested copy of complete file with regard to above mentioned godowns lying in your office.

I am attaching the postal order of Rs 10 bearing no. 57F.802423 and is ready to pay the fees which will be incurred to prepare this information. So, you are requested to supply the attested copy of this information after marking page number on it.

Note: That the applicant is the member of Ashok Kumar HUF and Ashok Kumar HUF is co-owner of M/s Bahadur Singh Co-owner. Therefore, the information which the applicant seeks is not third party information and section 8 of RTI Act, 2005 does not applies to this RTI application.

3. Thereafter, the appellant filed the first appeal and feeling aggrieved, he filed the second appeal before the Commission. Accordingly, a notice of hearing was issued to the parties. In the interest of natural justice, the case was adjourned number of times and the reasonable opportunities were given to the parties in this case. After the detailed deliberations with both the parties, the case was reserved on 23.04.2025.

4. The perusal of the case file shows that with regard to Point No. 1 to 6, no deficiency has been received from the appellant. Regarding Point No. 7 and 8, the respondent pleaded that the information sought relates to third party and also categorically submitted that the litigation of the appellant and his father namely, Sh. Ashok Kumar is pending, in which Punjab State Warehousing Corporation has been arrayed as a party, so request of the appellant to provide the information is not accepted. Regarding Point No. 9, the appellant stated that he has received the most of the information but according to the appellant the said information is incomplete.

Also, the appellant stated that the deficiencies have been pointed out to the respondent many times and during the hearing on 31.07.2023 but according to the case file, no deficiency of dated 31.07.2023 has been received from the appellant and also the deficiencies have not received from the appellant along with the rebuttal filed in this case when the case was reserved. Since, no deficiency has been received from the appellant, therefore, no further directions are being given to the respondent in this regard.

5. Keeping in view the above, the Commission is of the view that no further action is required to be taken in this case. As such, this case is **disposed of & closed**.
